


## Quarter 2 Highlights

### 2019-2020 FEAHS Summary of location and hours

We are located in room 210 in the Abbotsford High School District. The program will continue to serve students from both the Abbotsford and Colby School Districts for the 2019-2020 school year. FEAHS will run Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Minimum hours of attendance are 17.5 hours/week and 3.5 hours/day. Instructor determines whether students need to attend more than the minimum hours based on credits obtained upon enrollment, work pace and job status. AM session runs from 8 - 11:30 a.m. PM session runs from 12 - 3:30 p.m.

### Hands on Learning

Students in Biology class were able to get some hands on learning experience thanks to Mrs. Wolf's generosity of letting FEAHS borrow a microscope. Students have been able to view and study animal and plant cells. The use of the microscope lets students identify the internal structures of cell and connect those structures to their specific functions. Students also created a "3 D" Project displaying the functions and structure of animal cells by comparing it to a model used in everyday life. The picture below shows one students project using Oreos and sprinkles to represent each phase of the cell division process.



### PBIS

The PBIS system at FEAHS encourages students to stay on track with courses, make responsible choices, be safe, and respectful. Students are rewarded for positive behavior and work ethic through the generous support of the Abbotsford Education Foundation. Students may either pick a personal prize or pick a group activity.
