## Senior Graduation Reminder



Seniors are required to meet Abbotsford Graduation Requirements, including 4 credits of English, 3 credits of mathematics, 3 credits of Social Studies, 3 credits of Science, 1.5 credits of Physical Education, 1 credit of Computer Applications, .5 credits of Personal Finance and 8 credits of electives, for a total of 24 credits.

In addition, they must complete the civics exam with at least a 65%.

They must present their ACP Portfolio to a team made up of administration, teachers and community members and earn a passing grade.

Students must have paid all time obligations, fines, fees, and other financial obligations owed to the school district in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.
